


HOW B COMM CONSTRUCTORS


Turnkey Services and Self-Supply

To address this, BComm Constructors acquired a fleet of Cemen Tech C60 volumetric concrete trucks to self-supply materials, enhancing operational efficiency and eliminating material shortages.



The C60 trucks supplied by ROMCO offer reliability, consistency, and operational efficiency, crucial for maintaining high standards across all projects. By using these advanced trucks, BComm Constructors can control product quality, ensuring uniform and high-quality telecommunications infrastructure.

"We're providing a unique product in terms of telecom construction, but it's so crucial that it's uniform in all parts of the town, all parts of the state, all parts of the country," says Baldwin. Flexibility and Productivity

From backfill situations to flat work areas, primarily for excavation restoration. BComm Constructors utilizes its equipment in various scenarios. The flexibility of volumetric trucks allows the company to meet diverse project needs, enhancing overall productivity. "You don't realize what needs you have for this type of equipment until you actually have it," says Baldwin.

One of the key advantages is the ability to change mixes on demand. When city officials have specific requirements, the mix can be adjusted on the spot with simple button controls. This flexibility allows the company to meet diverse project needs and ensures compliance with local regulations. "We have four or five different mix designs on here," said Francisco Salcedo, Volumetric Operator. "It's just making a few minor adjustments on the pad and then it comes out."

Salcedo continues, "You're pretty much in control of everything. Let's say you need it to be a little bit darker or less, you can adjust everything on the fly. With the ready-mix trucks, once the truck gets there, you have to pour it out because it'll dry up or you'll have to ask for another truck. The volumetric mixer works perfect for this kind of job because you can control from the wetness to it, when to start, when if you need to stop, you can take a break. It won't dry up because whatever you pour out is just what's on the auger."

Trucks are able to pivot and shift across town at any given time period, including afterhours outages or emergencies. The ability to cycle through close to 100 yards of material daily underscores the efficiency of BComm's operations.

Enhancing Sustainability

BComm Constructors is committed to sustainability, aligning with the company's environmental policy. The volumetric trucks produce minimal waste, and the materials used are clean and stored properly, reducing the risk of contamination. This focus on sustainability ensures that the company's operations have a minimal environmental impact.
